Officer's Reports

Chatelaine:

- One thing you will notice is that there is a Large Lack of articles, messages and other entries for me to include other than the agenda of the Moot. Exchequer:

- The bank account balance is \$5144.49.
- General Fund \$4628.49
- Pavilion Fund **\$516.00**
- All quarterly reports and the Doomsday report for 2011 have been submitted to the Kingdom Exchequers bringing Marinus up-to-date with the Kingdom Exchequer.
- Last year the Barony operated at a loss of \$587.89. The Income Statement and Balance Sheet for 2011 are available for anyone who would like to see them and they are also posted on Marinus' website.
- Aislinn has agreed to be my deputy and I will be working with her over the next few months so that she is trained and ready to take over after a Review of Books is done on the kingdom level (probably after the Kingdom staff is done with their Doomsday stuff).
- Storage unit is main cost for the group at \$100.
- Need to have more Demos to get cash donations, and events to make money to support group.

Herald:

• Rhiannon would like to thank everyone for their support and enthusiasm during the past year. She has turned over the position of Baronial Herald

- to Isabella Delfino, and hopes that you will all give her the support and encouragement you gave her. Rhiannon will still be assisting as needed.
- The last LoAR indicated that Tor had a submission pass.
- The Interbaronial 12th Night court report has been submitted.
- Hrothny can no longer take individual submissions now that she has a kingdom position. It would be a conflict of interest. Please see Isabella Delfino or other Heralds in the barony.

Knight Marshal:

• Looking at doing practices indoors. However schools want there to be a security guard and custodian on site and paid for by us. Norfolk system would be \$65 per day.

Mistress of Arts & Sciences:

- Current MoAS must step down. Position needs to be filled. Oda voted unanimously as new MoAS.
- The Baronial Beautification Program Continues!

Twenty baldrics have been cut out, and half assembled. I'll let everyone know when the next opportunity to lend a hand will be.

I proposed a make one take one workshop -where you would bring your own supplies and make one bench for the barony and one for yourself. Is there still interest? If no one likes the make one take one idea, I can price the cost of wood etc. Also needed would be a pattern. Tor states he has a pattern that breaks down flat.
