An Introduction To Heraldry

Heraldry is an important part of the SCA. We don't expect everyone to learn everything about it, but we do hope that everyone will know something about it and how we use it. At some point, you'll probably want to have heraldry of your own.

To begin – What is heraldry?

We've all seen the painted shields, the painted and embroidered banners and surcotes. Heraldry does dress up an event – and a nice surcote can hide really ugly armour. But it's more than just decoration. Lots of people painted their shields and used flags. What makes it heraldry is that it's a system, a way of telling who someone is.

There are two kinds of designs in heraldry: Coats of arms or devices, and badges.

In the SCA, a coat of arms and a device are used the same way. The only difference is if the owner has an Award of Arms. If he does, it's a coat of arms. If he doesn't, it's a device.

If you see someone with a design on his shield, that design is probably his coat of arms or device. It's his and his alone. No one else is allowed to wear it (except a herald). I have my coat of arms on my shields, and on a surcote, and on a couple of flags. Anyone who sees the design, a red saltire (X-shaped cross) on a gold field with four gold anchors on the saltire, can tell that I'm at an event, because I don't let anyone else use that design.

A coat of arms with a laurel wreath on it belongs to a branch (shire, barony, or Kingdom), instead of to a person. You can fly a flag with a branch coat of arms if the head of the branch (the seneschal or baron or king) is at the event, but only the head of the branch (or a herald) can wear it.

Sometimes you see a group of people wearing the same thing. That's a different kind of heraldry called a badge. The owner doesn't usually wear his own badge, but the people who work with him and fight with him do. Only I wear my coat of arms, but anyone who is in my household could wear my badge. And if I had several men fighting with me as a team, I'd have them wear surcotes with my badge on them. That makes them look sharp and like a team. That sort of thing is called livery, and it's an early form of uniform.

Branch badges are used the same way. Say a barony has a coat of arms and a badge. If the fighters in that barony all fight as a team, the baron would wear the barony's coat of arms or have it painted on his shield (so would the Baroness, if she's a fighter). The other fighters would wear the badge or maybe paint it on their shields.

A shield is the most common place to see a coat of arms or device, but there are lots of other places someone can use it.

There are lots of different kinds of flags people can use. One that's mostly square is called a banner. One that's a triangle shape is called a pennant. The really long narrow ones you see with all kinds of different

pictures on them are called standards. There are about a dozen other types of flags, and that can be a different lesson.

Anything a person owns can be marked with his coat of arms or device. Furniture like chairs and tables, storage chests, armour stands and weapon stands, even pets. Some people make little covers like saddle blankets with their coat of arms to put on a dog. This helps people to know whose the things are and makes them easier to return if they get lost.

There's a lot more to it, but I hope this brief introduction has made it less of a mystery to you. The Heraldry section of the SCA's Web site has lots of interesting stuff, and any herald can answer your questions about it. Heraldry isn't just for heralds. It's as old as the 14th century and as current as today's news. Enjoy it!
