BARONIAL BIRTHDAY

Marinus Celebrates XXVI Years as a Barony.

On as fine a fall day as one might hope for, the Barony of Marinus assembled to celebrate six and twenty years as a Barony. As a branch, Marinus is even older, for she was old as a group when she became a Barony, being founded in the dim dark pre-Atlantian history of this region. The actual date of founding is somewhat in dispute because the original paperwork was lost and had to be resubmitted, but Marinus goes back at least ten years prior to becoming a Barony, and during that time it went through numerous status changes, from Shire to Canton to Shire again (under the designation of City-State) and then to Province (called a Provincial City-State). To see this branch, which I've been involved with since its inception, prospering thus is heartening indeed.

One noteworthy aspect of the event is the number of people it drew from outside the Barony. Quite a few people made a pretty long trip to attend. Were they drawn by the event overall, or was it the prospect of a feast stewarded by Baroness Anne? We will probably never know. Their Excellencies Aldrydd and Isabel, wanting to observe the competitions that would assist them in choosing the martial champions, had those competitions held in sequence. We armored fighters, therefore, had plenty of time to prepare while

the archers demonstrated their skill at the range. I elected to fight in the Champions' Tourney just to make things more interesting. I've been a Baronial Champion before, and am quite happy to give others preference for the post. As it was, I ended up fighting a single match before going on to the main tourney. I will spare you a detailed account of the armored and rapier tournaments, but they were both "dice matches," in which the weapons forms were decided by a roll of the dice by the Ministers of the Lists. I was not all that happy that the dice kept coming up sword and shield, because I take great pleasure in a variety of styles. But in both arenas, the fighting was spirited, enthusiastic, and clean. I heard only praise and good words about any of the competitions or the competitors.

Those whose tastes ran to gentler pursuits were not neglected. Lady Oda held a well-attended class in drop-spindle spinning. It was rewarding but a bit frustrating to some. It IS a tricky art to perform. The Arts and Sciences competition involved hiding modern items in period-looking style. The creativity was admirable. A wonderful day board was also spread for the benefit of all. I was grateful to Catherine for bringing me a plate from it.

I have to confess that it was with some reluctance that I repaired to the hall for Court and then the Feast, because so beautiful a day

was to be savored; but when the sun dropped below the trees, the temperature also began to drop. So in we went. I was accorded the honor of heralding Their Excellencies' Court, an honor tinged with sadness as two of our members, Gryffyth ap Anarawd and Olga Godunova, received the award of the Marlin in what will likely be their last event in Marinus, as they plan a move to the cold reaches of the East Kingdom. Cordell Hall was also awarded the Water Lily. Ruy de Rojas became the Armoured Champion, Ivarr Thorngilsson became Archery Champion, Oda Wislagne became Champion of Arts and Sciences, Robert Mac Andrew became Champion of Thrown Weapons, and Vittoria Cavalieri became Rapier Champion. Vivant, to all.

Of the feast, all one might need to say was that the Kitchen Steward was Baroness Anne du Cygne Noir. To any who know that Lady's culinary mastery, no more need be said. But let me say that by the end of the feast, we were like the piper . . . Pied! Pies dominated the menu, every one of which we had to take care not to eat too much because we knew that there was more to come. Even so, I was indeed surfeited by the end of the feast, barely able to enjoy the wondrous selections of cheesecakes that ended the repast. We did manage, somehow . . .

During the feast, we were also entertained by a variety of musical selections, some from the table at which Bishop Amos sat with several of his confreres. The Atlantian tradition of warrior-bards continues. All in all, it was a most excellent event. Rightly did the Autocrat, Lady Isabella Delfino, take the cheers of the company during the Court.

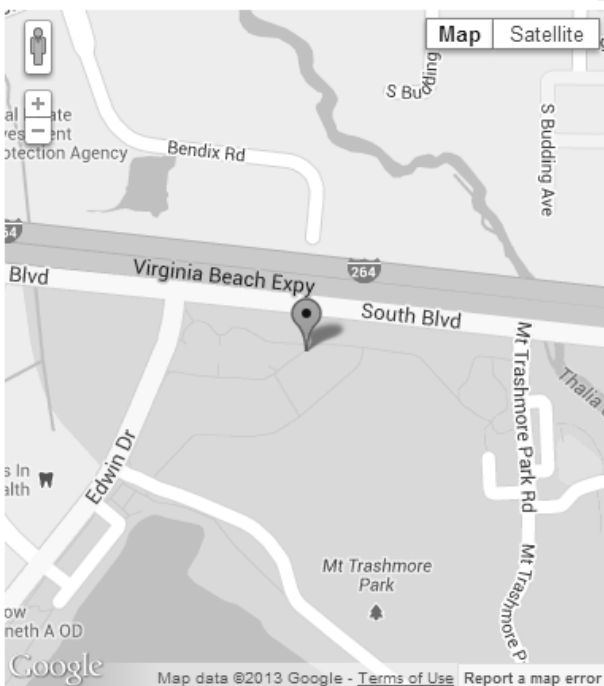
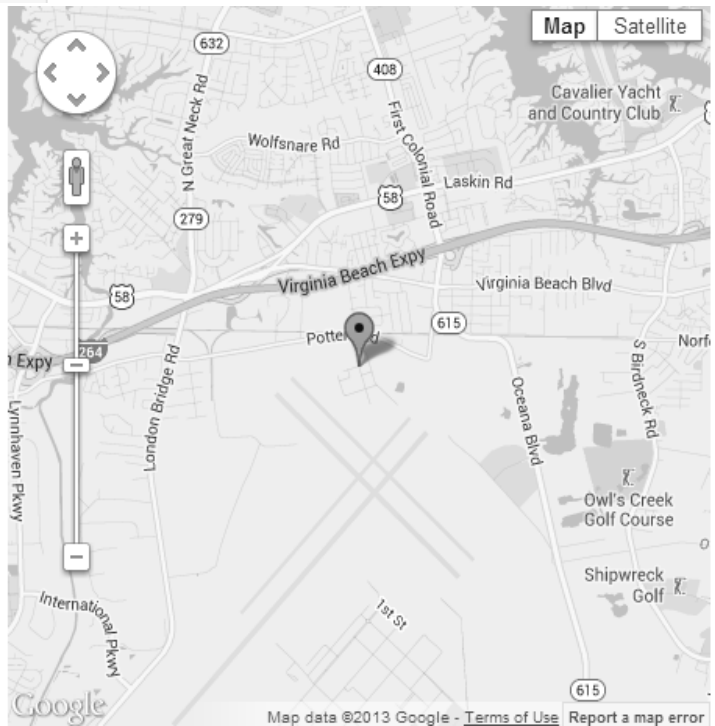
