

- I need a deputy who can step up to be the Baronial herald in September, so that I can step up as Golden Dolphin. Baronial Herald responsibilities include:
 - O Become warranted as herald.
 - O Make quarterly reports
 - Make sure their Excellencies have a court herald for any courts they hold. (The presiding coronets have the final say in who heralds their court)
 - O Make sure all baronial court reports are made, even if you didn't preside over that court
 - O Assist members of the barony with submissions
 - O Hold heraldry class as needed.
 - O Maintain Baronial Order of Precedence.
- Just remember, as Baronial herald you don't have to know everything about heraldry and you don't have to do it all. Just know what your resources are. Also know who your heralds are in your barony and what they specialize in. For example, if you don't like doing court, you just have to find someone in the barony who loves it and delegate it to them.
- Quarterly reports for all warranted heralds for 4th quarterly were due Jan 31st. If you are a warranted herald and have not made your report. Please use this website to do so http://herald.atlantia.sca.org/reporting.htm.
- 4th quarter report for the baronial herald has been made and copies were emailed to their Excellencies as well as the baronial seneschal.
