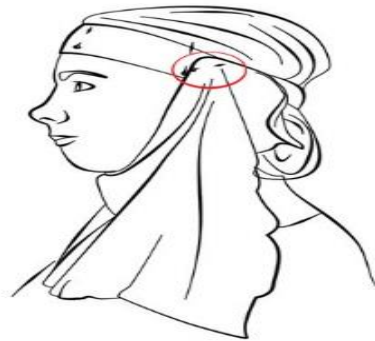
The next thing our Baronesa will be sharing is how to put on a veil, which is explained by a DeviantArt user who goes by, "eqos". All credits go to this user.

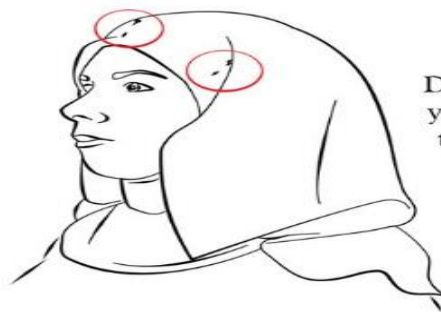


Wrap the headband tightly around your head, and pin it together.

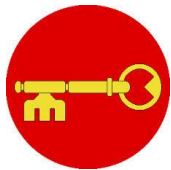
