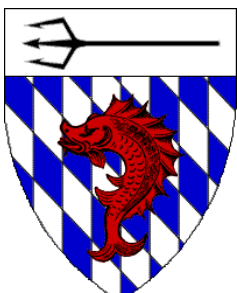

Moot was called to order at 7:37pm on Thursday, October 5th, 2017 and was adjourned at 8:45pm.

Officer Reports

Baron and Baroness:

Proposed moving from current meeting site [Christian Church Uniting] to new meeting site [Good Shepherd Lutheran Church] on Laskin Road in Virginia Beach. This was tabled and later discussed and acted upon as "New Business."

Chronicler:

1. Chronicler is assuming duties as secretary at business meetings and will keep the minutes and agenda.
2. Officer input and reports will now be submitted to the Chronicler, chronicler@marinus.atlantia.sca.org, by the 1st of each month for inclusion into the next business meeting's agenda.

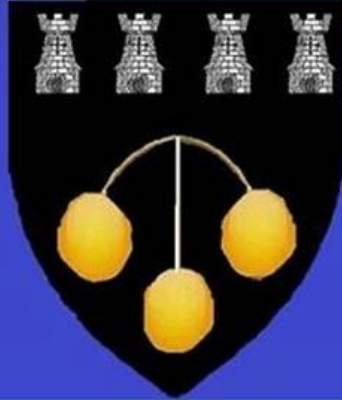

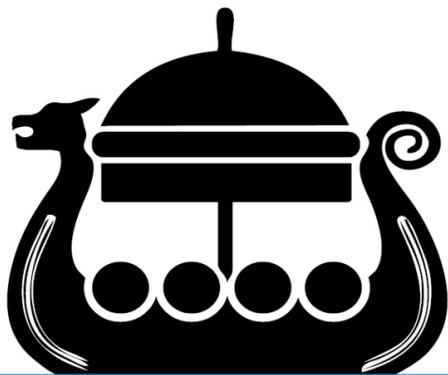
