

I found intriguing and quite fascinating the history of Martin Luther and the Reformation that began with his famous 95 theses on the door of All Saints' Church in Wittenberg. Some may have found the art on this issue's cover surprising, and perhaps objectionable, and I apologize for any offense, and I pray there is no offense as I discuss my choice of this cover art. Martin Luther is a lesson of strength, conviction, and fortitude. His is the story of one individual against a world power, where any moment could bring an excrutiating torture and execution, and yet he prevailed. 


