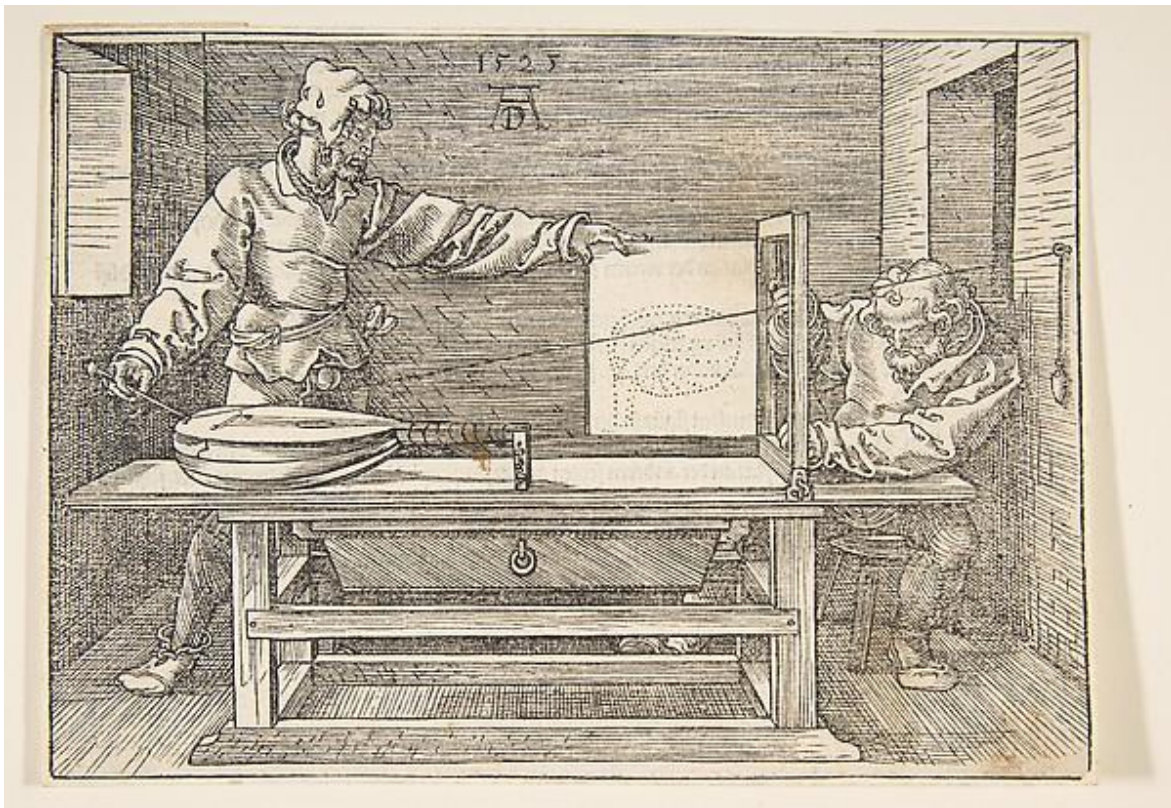

Theme: The naval feud between the Baronies of Tir-y-Don and Marinus continues to fester, the fate of Rip Rap Island which provides control of the Bay to its owner is still undetermined. The seas prove dangerous to all though and are creating havoc upon each Barony's shipping, as pirates and privateers pillage and plunder at will. Can these two Baronies come together, put their past feud behind, and fend off the onslaught from afar? For if not, they may both end up at the bottom of the bay and the Jolly Roger may fly high from Rip Rap instead....

Arts and Sciences: Arts and Science competitions will be announced soon but please plan for brewing and vinting competitions which have already been announced, there will also be a performing arts competition!

Camp Fee - \$5/tent (this is a tentative fee dependent on if the Baronies choose to enter long-term work for lower site fee agreement) This fee would be used to only offset site improvements paid for by Barony work and/or other agreements

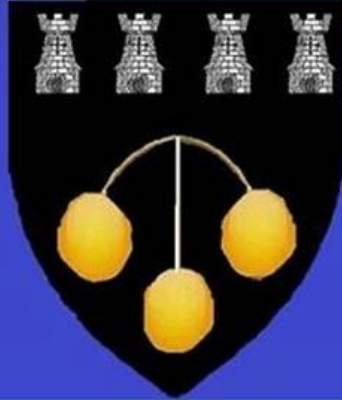

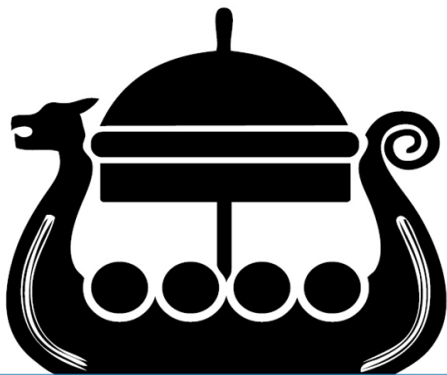
