Exchequer:

- Copy of bank statement received on 2/6/2021 for the period 1/1/2021 1/31/2021 showing no activity. The Barony currently enjoys a bank balance of \$ 7,666.19.
- Signatory cards from the Virginia Regional Exchequer and the Kingdom
 Exchequer have been received. An appointment with our banking advocate to
 finalize their implementation was scheduled for 12/10 at 12:30 and to affect the
 Exchequer change to Lucina of Southampton (Cindy Madison). A later revision
 will be to include the new Seneschal but that will be a local process.
- The Barony's Financial Policy has still not been approved to date.
- Warrants have been submitted to TRM.
- It is also time for us to conduct an inventory of all Baronial Property. This means laying eyes and hands on every piece of property the Barony owns including contents of the Baronial Storage unit, regalia, gold key, cooking equipment, Pennsic encampment accessories (that are local), loaner armor (both armored and rapier), archery equipment, camping equipment, office machines, etc.
- Next thing on the Exchequer's agenda will be a Review of Books in preparation for office turn over.
