NO OFFICIAL MEETING - DESSERT REVEL

Baronage/Nexcellencies:

Welcome to the New Year and many blessings. We look forward to Atlantian University in February and happy to see Marinusians are teaching again!

Exchequer:

- 1. All bills are paid and the Barony currently enjoys a bank balance of **\$7,666.19**. Account balanced 01/09/2021 after receiving the bank statement on Saturday,01/09 (!). (*signatures required*).
- 2. I am still in the process of setting up an appointment with our banking advocate to finalize the implementation of the last signature additions to our bank account. I will soon need to revise these to include the new Seneschal but that will be a local process. Thank you all for coming forward and helping me out on this.
- 3. Lady Lucinda and I will be working on the 4th quarter (Doomsday) report next week in hopes that we will have it signed, sealed and delivered well before the January 31st deadline. (*Seneschal signatures will be required*.)
- 4. I have not gotten any feedback from Kingdom yet on the acceptance of our Financial Policies.
- 5. Given the change in weather, I have postponed the time for us to conduct a physical inventory of all Baronial Property. [This means laying eyes and hands on every piece of property the Barony owns including contents of the Baronial Storage unit, regalia, gold key, cooking equipment, Pennsic encampment accessories (that are local), loaner armor (both armored and rapier), archery equipment, camping equipment, office machines, etc.]
- 6. However, I am asking all who are holding Baronial Property to send me an itemized list of what they are holding and if not too cumbersome, pictures of the same. A simple electronic word processing document will suffice (we will worry it into whatever format later). We are still striving toward creating an online inventory of Baronial Property for baronial members perusal at their leisure (of course).
- 7. Next thing on the agenda will be arranging for a Review of Books in preparation for office turn over.

Recipes to share

The Original Hot Buttered Rum Recipe

Ingredients

- 1 stick (4 ounces) unsalted butter
- ½ cup light brown sugar
- 1 teaspoon vanilla extract
- 1 teaspoon ground cinnamon
- 1 teaspoon ground cloves
- 1 teaspoon ground nutmeg
- 1 teaspoon ground allspice
- Pinch of salt
- 2 ounces dark or aged rum
- 6 ounces hot water
- Cinnamon stick, for garnish (optional)

Directions

In mixing bowl, combine butter, vanilla extract, sugar, spices and salt. Beat until well combined.

In heat-proof glass or mug, combine aged rum with 1 ounce (2 tablespoons) spiced butter mixture. Remaining batter can be stored in airtight container in refrigerator for future use.

Top with hot water and stir until ingredients are well incorporated. Garnish with cinnamon stick if preferred.

Lady Antoinette's Biscotti

Milt's Biscotti Preheat oven to 400 degrees Fahrenheit

Ingredients:

½ cup (1 stick) butter

1 cup sugar

2 eggs

1 ½ tsp vanilla

2 cups flour

½ tsp baking powder

½ tsp baking soda

1 1/2 cup chopped nuts

Directions:

- 1. Combine butter, sugar and eggs. Mix well. Beat in vanilla.
- 2. Combine all dry ingredients (flour, baking powder, baking soda, and nuts). Add to egg mix. Batter will be stiff and sticky. Cover with plastic wrap and refrigerate for 1 hour or overnight.
- 3. With floured hands, divide dough into equal parts. Shape each into approximately 12" long loaves (like French bread).
- 4. Grease a 10x14 baking sheet or line baking sheet with parchment paper. Place both loaves on sheet with about 3 inches separating them. Flatten each loaf slightly.
- 5. Bake in a pre-heated 400 degree Fahrenheit oven for 20 minutes or until firm to touch.
- 6. Remove from oven and let cool on rack slightly (15 minutes or less to cool).
- 7. Lower oven temperature to 375 degrees Fahrenheit.
- 8. Slice the loaves into diagonal slices about 1/3" thick. Arrange slices on ungreased baking sheet and return to 375 degree oven to bake until firm about 15 minutes. Do not brown.
- 9. Place on wire rack to cool completely. Store in airtight container. Makes about 3 dozen cookies. 10.

NOTE: For Cinnamon biscotti, use almond or pecans and add ¼ cup cinnamon to dry ingredients. Can also brush biscotti lightly with egg white and sprinkle with cinnamon sugar.
