- 4th quarter doomsday report (year 2020) was modified due to changes in Kingdom regalia rules. Need seneschal to resign the modified report.

Knight Marshal:

- No official Armored Combat, Rapier Combat, Youth Combat, Combat Archery practices held during February 2021. Virtual events as alternatives continue to be a viable option.
- Official Target Archery practices continue every Saturday at NAS Oceana Skeet and Archery Range.
- Thrown Weapons. No official Thrown Weapon practices was held.
- At this time, our barony does not enjoy the service of an equestrian marshal.
- Marinus implements MORE strict guidance to ensure the safety of our populace and continues to remain with the original Reopening Atlantia guidelines published in 2020. We have implemented a color-coded tier level that meets the established KOA COVID positivity rate threshold of 5%. The threshold is as follows:
 - 2% 3% YELLOW
 - o 3% 4% ORANGE
 - 4% 5% RED. WILL SUSPEND PRACTICE UNTIL LEVELS RETURN TO SAFE CONDITIONS.
- Each week "Senora" Ilhuicacihuatl de Xochimilco and I review the positivity rate trending in our area. We will continue to coordinate this information and I will include trend updates each Wednesday / Thursday when posting Saturday Archery practice notice, which will allow each person the opportunity to decide their level of comfort to attend practice
- In addition to the current KOA and Marinus COVID mitigation strategies we implement each and every martial practice, as an additional measure I purchased a hand held digital non-contact forehead infrared thermometer. This will be used at the beginning of every official practice while covering the COVID safety questionnaire.
- As of Apr 8, all baronies are at phase 0.

- Baroness Catalina's Fall Event Proposal. November 11-14 2021. Camp Apasis. Working on submitting a budget. Theme will be Archery (Company of Neptune) and thrown weapons. Any volunteers (marshals, etc.) contact Baroness Catalina Riguel De Luna. Sir Otto moved to approve the budget/event if the Financial committee approves the proposed budget. 100% in favor of the motion. Motion passed. If Financial Committee approves the budget, the event is a go.
- Financial Committee E-list review. Baron and Baroness, Exchequer, Seneschal, Sir Otto, and Lady Antoinette. Need to add Master Arn as deputy exchequer.
- Known World New World Symposium Proposal. Contacted by Society MOAS asked to do the first Known World New World Symposium. Date is 11 September with a possible additional day 12 September, depending on class bids. Yzma will autocrat the event. Do we want to allow for static A&S displays? If so Yzma would need a small budget for prizes – but that is it. It will be a virtual event. Sir Otto moves to accept the event proposal pending approval by Financial committee. 100% in favor. Motion passed. If Financial committee approves the budget, the event is a go.
