Baronial Trailer Back Taxes - Seneschal has been working with His Excellency Jean-Maurice to confirm the amount necessary to cure our tax delinquency with the city. His Excellency has found that there are substantial left over funds from previous years' camp fees and that the Pennsic Camp should be able to cover the greater share of what is due. Based on conversations at July Moot, Seneschal has communicated to His Excellency that the Barony will assist in settling the delinquent taxes from our general fund, provided that Marinus camp fees for Pennsic are increased to cover this expense in the future. Update: The back taxes are paid in full and going forward, the cost will be \$10.50 yearly – easy enough to pay via camp fees.
