- Would like to schedule inventory in May before May 23.
- Still looking for event budgets. Once budgets are received will schedule financial committee meeting to approve the budgets.

Quartermaster:

Knight Marshal:

- No official Armored Combat, Rapier Combat, Youth Combat, Combat Archery practices held during April 2021. Virtual events as alternatives continue to be a viable option.
- Official Target Archery practices continue every Saturday at NAS Oceana Skeet and Archery Range.
- Thrown Weapons. No official Thrown Weapon practices was held.
- At this time, our barony does not enjoy the service of an equestrian marshal.
- Marinus implements MORE strict guidance to ensure the safety of our populace and continues to remain with the original Reopening Atlantia guidelines published in 2020. We implemented a color-coded tier level that meets the established KOA COVID positivity rate threshold of 5%. The threshold is as follows:
 - 2% - 3% YELLOW
 - 3% - 4% ORANGE
 - 4% - 5% RED. WILL SUSPEND PRACTICE UNTIL LEVELS RETURN TO SAFE CONDITIONS.
- Each week "Senora" Ilhuicacihuatl de Xochimilco, called Yzma, and I review the positivity rate trending in our area. We will continue to coordinate this information and I will include trend updates each Wednesday/Thursday when posting Saturday Archery practice notice, which will allow each person the opportunity to decide their level of comfort to attend practice.

- Fighters, review your fighter cards to ensure they are up-to-date. You can renew your own cards.
- Deputy Earl Marshall requires you have a mask from the time you leave your car until you get back in your car, unless consuming food or beverages. Bring plenty of masks.

Seneschal:

- If you are planning to propose an event, please give attention to the many memos and announcements that are coming from Society about restrictions on events and practices. Please make sure you have made arrangements for the current most restrictive scenario - no camping, no feast, all masked activities, 150 people or less, pre-registration required using PayPal or SCARS, etc. Please feel free to message or call me if you have questions.
- The following is Society policy regarding the wearing of masks. Please remember that masking is required at all activities, including outdoor activities such as martial practices. Items such as clear face shields and face veils are not considered masks. Masks with large holes or breathing vents are also not acceptable, per CDC guidelines.
 - VI. *Resolved*, that all attendees in North America must follow all province, territory, state, and local health guidelines at SCA events. In addition, at all North American SCA events:
 - A. Masks that fully cover the mouth and nose must be worn by all attendees over the age of 4 at all times and during all activities except for eating and drinking;
 - B. Court, bardic circles, or any activity that involves voice projection shall also require that masks be worn at all times. Sound amplification devices are highly recommended;



C. No day board, water bearing, or food of any kind shall be provided by event staff or attendees to other attendees. All attendees must provide their own food and beverages;

D. While consuming food or beverages, attendees are required to remain stationary and follow social distancing rules: <https://www.sca.org/news/resolutiontoliftsuspensionapril2021/>
