This month's contribution is a letter from a traveler - please read and enjoy.

Lettres de Voyage

Sister,

Father's merchantmen have set my feet towards Paris. I still haven't decided between fear and excitement. The voyage was uneventful. The sailors say that I have sea legs. Lord Bunnall does not but he recovered in time for us to proceed to Bruges, where I was confined to Master Armel's house due to rioting in the streets between Catholics and heratics. I am disgusted – I was given no chance to show that I could handle my blade and no longer be treated as a child. But he cautioned me to discretion. We are in the minority here. Although we did celebrate Mass in the Cathedral and I saw a vial of Christ's Holy Blood. It has been there since 1303, they say, and was brought from the Holy Land by Count Theirry d'Alsace. I felt such awe when I gazed upon it. Imagine! God's blood! Lord Bunnall gave the cathedral one of his rings in appreciation. They say that the vial may be taken into hiding until the troubles are over.

We journeyed through Ath afterwards, where there was no unrest and instead a festival was going on. There were giant figures of David and Goliath lofted high in a parade and then a battle between them took place in the market field, which we watched from our horses before we assayed our Inn. David won, of course, but Goliath was heard to say, "But I'm not dead yet!" I found this handful of silk threads at the market after Lord Bunell gave me leave to wander. With a manservant. Like a baby. I pray that you enjoy them and think of me while you embroider something snarled and colourful.

We lay at Arras tomorrow. I am told I will meet my Latin master there as he has been travelling in the North. I shall part with Lord Bunnell then and journey on with my new master to Paris. May he be a jolly man and not a dour and loveless tyrant such as Blewett [his tutor] was!

Please give our stepmother my regards and tell her that I cherish the token she enclosed in my luggage. It cheered my heart after the voyage when home became so far away. Tell her that she will always be our true mother, as the Lord shewed kindness to us by His gift to our Father. Take good care of my hound and don't sneak too much of your dinner to him. He is grown fat enough.

in loving regard I sign myself your brother,

If Peters doesn't deliver this to your hand I shall beat him.

There should be 18 bundles of silk threads and one of gold.

Ask Mother to send me more stockings. I put holes in my newest pair whilst learning to climb the masts on the way over sea. Don't tell Father about that, though.

I enclose a letter to our lord Father with this. If you read it before you give it to him, it will not make him happy. So, do not. Remember last winter!
