Toddlers at Twelfth Night: It Takes a Village.

I decided, at the last possible second, in a fit of ambition, to attempt to bring myself and my children (ages almost 3 and 1) to 12th night. Solo. Site is only 30 minutes from home, I said. What's the worst that could happen, I said.

My children were very excited to wear their "decorations" so they could attend the party - and looking for the "decoration" on everyone the saw. Rather than torturing them with court, we decided to hang out with our merchant friends, where the 3-year-old learned all about keeping livestock from the Bedouin merchants, and the one year old attempted to run for freedom, giggling. She paused only to clap along with the populace, whenever someone was honored - clapping is of course, very important.

Then court ended, and the twelfth night debauchery began. Chocolate coins, Turkish Delight, rosewater cookies, chocolate chip cookies, Hershey kisses --- the generosity of the kingdom was visited upon these babes, like nothing they had ever imagined. They were carried and cuddled, hugged and welcomed.

And then the 3-year-old learned about true luxury - by being thrown into a pile of silk saris. Over and over This, of course, was the last straw in the day of debauch; when I needed her to leave the vast ocean of color and texture, she had one of the days loudest meltdowns. We retreated to the car and spent a good portion of time allowing the children to chill, decrease stimulation, and actually eat some food with nutritional value in it.

One of my own most dearly held memories of the day was when we returned, after the tantrum. I was greeted by three or four different members of my barony, all with stories of when their own children were little, and their own children's moments of disaster in the SCA, and the constant refrain that it will get easier as they get older, and that these children were welcome here, come as they are.

The afternoon was a blur and I only remember snippets - our Baroness's daughter running in circles with my girls, helping wear them out. My toddler standing in the middle of a Persian dance class whispering "woooooow," trying to get her fingers in the right shape, and tip toeing in circles like the ladies were. My one year old enthralled by the bardic competition and would have happily stayed listening for the rest of the event. My eldest child receiving her first piece of largess; a paternoster and running the beads through her hands over and over. Holding my one year old, while looking up at the very tall grown man who first wore her hand me down tunic. Over and over, someone I knew watching one child for just a moment while I took care of a need of the other child. How aching and tired and happy I was when we did get home in the early evening, well before afternoon court, or feast, or any of the rest of it.

It really took the village for me to be able to attend the event, and I appreciate every last bit of aid, encouragement, and just being there everyone around us offered. That, for me, was the best twelfth night present I could have ever received. Thank you, everyone.
