Herald: Currently, offensive name and armory changes are free. If you have a name or armory that is offensive or may be offensive, please see Magnifica Seraphina or Lady Antoinette for more information.

Exchequer:

- 1. All bills are paid and the Barony currently enjoys a bank balance of **\$ 7,827.63**. Account balanced 07/12/2020 after receiving the bank statement yesterday. (*signatures required*).
- 2. USA Independence Day week-end incurred a flurry of e-mails from the Kingdom Exchequer and her staff resulting in action items with deadlines.

a.Kingdom Financial Policy has been updated to conform with a new template (that the SCA Corporate body has provided) and is currently with Their Majesties for perusal and approval.
Kingdom Exchequer stated that this new template must be used and followed without modifications. I am currently reviewing the Barony's Financial Policies to see what changes



must be made to conform with the new template. With that in mind, I foresee a full Financial Committee meeting in the near future and a Moot presentation and vote. We have until December 31st, 2020 to have our changes made, approved and submitted to the Kingdom Exchequer via our Regional Exchequer for inclusion to the Kingdom of Atlantia official website. - b. We must update our bank signature cards before the October 31st, 2020 or face suspension by our Kingdom Seneschal. This process is going to involve a lot of time mailing forms back and forth and starts off with me e-mailing a list to our Regional Exchequer and up the chain for approval. The process has begun. All signatories must be 18 years of age or older, SCA Members in good standing for at least 90 days into the future, cannot share a domicile with another signatory, and cannot be our sitting Baron or Baroness. Our upcoming polling and Investiture may play havoc with this process and result in us repeating several steps but it must be done. At the present time our signatories consist of:
 - 1. Baronial Exchequer (Me)
 - 2. Baronial Deputy Exchequer (Susan Lamb)
 - 3. Former Seneschal (Sam Peterson now regional seneschal)
 - 4. Kingdom Emergency Exchequer (Kathy Gildemeister) not local
 - 5. and no others.

We need to add:

- 1. Our current Seneschal (Greg Lemich)
- 2. Our current Baronial Deputy (Cindy Madison)
- 3. Our Kingdom Exchequer (Robin Leguillow) not local
- 4. Our Regional VA Exchequer (Debbie de Treville) not local
- 5. And any other volunteers who wish to come forth and participate in an easily done baronial service.
- 3. It is also time for us to conduct an inventory of all Baronial Property. This means laying eyes and hands on every piece of property the Barony owns including contents of the Baronial Storage unit, gold key, cooking equipment, Pennsic encampment accessories (that are local), loaner armor (both armored and rapier), archery equipment, camping equipment, office machines, etc. I am open to suggestions as to how & when to schedule these activities but I would like to have the inventory complete before rainy & cold weather descends upon us.
- 4. I hold this office at the whim of the Kingdom and will of the Barony and my warrant expires in December 2020. I am willing to serve beyond that date but feel as though my time as exchequer should come to a close especially since there are two more able individuals currently warranted who may serve the Barony better. I will continue to serve and assist in whatever capacity is needed in the future.
- 5. Thank you, Cindy Madison, for responding with such positive enthusiasm and offering to step up to become the Exchequer when I step down. We'll still need to run it by MOOT but I wanted to express my gratitude before I got carried away with other things.

Quartermaster:

Alexa brought back the Kitchen stuff and Jess Hellar brought back the signs and things in her car but I think the troll box and decorations that Megan had, have not been returned. 1. Baronial Polling Timeline and Details

<u>Please note that this timeline is tentative</u>. It is subject to the will of the Crowns and may need to adjust due to state and local closures. Also, in order to receive a polling, you must be an SCA member and have your mailing address in the Barony of Marinus.

- Now: Sign Up for Electronic Polling. Please log into the Baronial Polling site at the bottom of the page. Ensure that you are attached to the Barony of Marinus and registered to poll electronically (if you so choose). To login, you will need an AEL account (same as your fighter card and university login). If you do not have an AEL, the link to create one is also listed below. Every person who polls electronically saves the Barony about \$2 in mailing costs. Opting in for electronic polling must be done more than 7 days before the polls open.
- 8/21: Meet the Candidates gathering
- 8/29: Polling Mailed. A paper polling will be mailed out to everyone who did not opt in for the electronic polling.
- 8/31: Electronic Polling Open. Everyone who opted in to poll electronically may now do so.
- 9/19: Polls Due to Their Majesties. Electronic polls close and mailed polling must be postmarked by this day.
- 10/3: Candidates are Notified. Their Majesties contact the candidates with their decision. Once all candidates are notified, Their decision will be announced to the populous.
- 11/14: Investiture. Celebrate 5 wonderful year from our outgoing Baron and Baroness and welcome 3 new years from our incoming.
