Herald:

Thank you to Magnifica Seraphina for having a Herald's consult table this month. Hoping to have this once a quarter. We had two submissions for arms.

Exchequer:

- We currently enjoy a balance of \$4,948.30 as of this 5th day of July in the year 2019. [I have not received June's Bank Statement as of yet so this is based on my figures alone.]
- Check for the Annual Storage Unit Fee (\$ 770.00 one month free for the annual payment) has been delivered to the storage facility (and receipt obtained) so we have a storage unit for another year.
- I stopped by the Khedive Temple Wednesday, July 3rd and spoke with their Facilities Manager and the Office worker, relayed the news that our bid was turned down, and asked what procedure I had to follow in order to get our deposit back. I was told that they could cancel the event on my word and would process a check for the deposit [\$ 1,000.00] as soon as their Treasurer returned from vacation which would be July 16th and I could pick up the check on Thursday. July 18th if I so desired...
- Event report for Old School War Practise (OSWP) has been finalized. The event earned a profit of \$ 361.87 after all bills have been paid. This includes a \$ 142.00 site fee for the Silverleaf Estates property maintenance fund. My thanks to the Tollner Baroness Catalina and her staff for keeping accurate records (really does make the job a lot easier) and the Autocrat Baron Mungoe who had lots of help maintaining the flow and pace for the event. Lord Paganus was a major help getting all the gate receipts tallied up and reconciled.
- I have received the inventory for the Knight Marshal's office but no other as of this date. This is another project that will be delayed and I would still like everyone who holds any baronial property to inventory said property and submit an identifying descriptive list with quantities to me at or before the MOOT to be held on <u>September 10th</u>. This information will be consolidated into a master inventory list to be posted with our Quartermaster and possibly the website. I will make myself available for anyone who requires assistance getting this accomplished in time for our end of the year report.
- Projects to renovate various pieces of baronial property are being put on hold until after Pennsic when I will begin scheduling a series of work days.
- The second quarter exchequer's report is looming on the horizon (due 31 July 2019). [Note: Pennsic begins 26 July 2019 and I have an obligation to be there and working on Wednesday, July 24th.]
