Upcoming Demos:

Appearing on WTKR weekday morning show:

- As I'm sure everyone saw, we have an opportunity to be on TV on a local talk show called "Coast Live."

- There is a signup sheet online as well as one with me today. You **MUST** sign up in order to be a part of this demo! I have to give a list of the people to the producer and we have only a certain number of spots. Unfortunately, we can only have a maximum of six people participate (2 to interview and 3-4 to be introduced as part of the fashion show).
 - I will contact everyone beforehand to confirm attendance, and in the event that we have too many people signed up for the demo.
- The producer (Dan Cawley) and I spoke of the possibility of doing more broadcasts involving the barony in the future. This is an awesome opportunity to get our collective foot in the door!

Southampton Renaissance Faire

- As always, camping is available. As long as the weather isn't as terrible as it was last year, I am planning to camp.
- Even if you are a new person yourself, this demo is an **AWESOME** time!! It is a Renaissance Festival with open admission, so it is **FREE** to come!
- We will talk more specifics next month. There will be a signup sheet for this demo as well. We don't need to provide anyone with final numbers. However, I would like to know who is planning to camp and what all people are planning to bring for the demo so we have an idea of the space we need and the numbers we will have!
- Donation to the Church – our last donation to Good Shepherd was in July of last year for \$300. Discussion followed about whether money was the most appropriate or needed resource. Baroness Catalina will contact the secretary of the church for more information about what they need and will report back at the next moot.
- Pennsic – **IT'S COMING!** Pr-registrants are now able to select the Barony of Marinus for their camp site. Baroness Catalina proposed a meeting of the Pennsic Action Committee in the coming weeks to make decisions involving improvements to the camp site and a possible increase in camp fees.
- Day of Challenge - Cooking and A&S events were discussed, specifically the foraging aspect of the event. Dame Hrothny has been in contact with Silverleaf on this issue.
- Ruby Joust – The big pavilion will be used for the populace. Our auxiliary pavilion will be loaned to the archers for their use.

- Regalia Fund – Bethoc brought up a post on the Kingdom facebook page concerning the cost of breaking the contract with Founder's Inn and how the fee for that contract would eat into the funds the Kingdom was hoping to use for updates and improvements to regalia. She proposed a baronial donation to the fund in order that the Kingdom feel more comfortable breaking the contract with Founder's Inn. Options for the donation were discussed. Seraphina suggested that we wait for Kingdom instruction before making any monetary donation, as funds that are earmarked must be used for specific purposes and our preemptive donation may not be as helpful as we would like. Dame Hrothny decided that she will host a merchant tent at Day of Challenge to benefit the Kingdom, specifically marking the funds to be used “as the Kingdom finds to be best”. The tent will function as a “spring cleaning” sale and members of the Barony are encouraged to be gently used items to donate.
