#### Exchequer:

1. We currently enjoy a bank balance of \$8,787.46 which balanced with our latest bank statement which arrived today (Saturday, October 9th). (Signatures required...)

2. Marinus' 3rd Quarter Exchequer's report was filed on time and balanced with all our records. (Signatures required...)

3. The Marinus Financial Committee met and conducted a thorough Financial Policy Review. Several wording changes were discussed and are incorporated into a revised Financial Policy. Copies will be available at the meeting for the populace to review prior to voting on its acceptance. Upon being signed, I will make pdf copies for posting on the website and copies for the officers.

4. I have not yet gotten together with the storage unit manager to iron out our contract with them. [I am in receipt of a letter from the Airline Self-Storage facility informing us of a \$15.00 per month increase in our storage unit fee effective November 1st, 2019. This will bring our annual payment up to \$1,020.00 if we do not receive any discounts for paying annually. This increase will fund improvements in the units to include an electronic gate (no word if that means expanded hours of operation), unit repairs, better lighting, security cameras, paving, drainage, better parking and more of it. I will be talking with them to ascertain whether we will owe more for the remainder of this year (since we generally pay each June putting us 6 months out.)]


