Gold Key Deputy:

Baronial Herald's third quarter report is complete and submitted.

Exchequer:

1. All bills are paid and the Barony currently enjoys a bank balance of **\$ 7,667.19**. *(Even though Jason Frawley generously donated his refund check back to the Barony, we are down from \$ 7,827.63 after reimbursing the Baronial polling expenses and the cost of the fabric for the Baronial Investiture Banner Project.).* Account balanced 10/03/2020 after receiving the bank statement on Saturday,10/03. *(signatures required)*.
2. Hopefully, by the time this becomes part of the official agenda (we are meeting at 15:00 on Friday, October 9, 2020 to wrap this up), the new Bank Account Signatories will have signed the



signature card and helped make my life easier when that second signature is needed to pay our expenses. Thank you all for coming forward and taking up the reins of baronial service.

3. I am still in the process of revising the format of the Barony's Financial Policies to conform with the new template. Cindy and I will be getting together to polish up the new document probably next week. With that in mind, I foresee a full Financial Committee meeting toward the end of the month and a Moot presentation to vote on its adoption. We have until December 31st, 2020 to have our changes made, approved and submitted to the Kingdom Exchequer via our Regional Exchequer for inclusion to the Kingdom of Atlantia official website.

4. It is also time for us to conduct an inventory of all Baronial Property. This means laying eyes and hands on every piece of property the Barony owns including contents of the Baronial Storage unit, regalia, gold key, cooking equipment, Pennsic encampment accessories (that are local), loaner armor (both armored and rapier), archery equipment, camping equipment, office machines, etc. I would like to have the inventory complete before rainy & cold weather descends upon us.
