Exchequer:

- 1. All bills are paid and the Barony currently enjoys a bank balance of \$7,827.63. Account balanced 09/06/2020 after receiving the bank statement on Saturday,09/05. (signatures required).
- 2. My warrant expires in December 2020. I am willing to serve beyond that date but feel as though my time as exchequer should come to a close especially since there are two more able individuals currently warranted who may serve the Barony better.
- 3. I am continuing to work on the items below though work has me slammed at the moment and I haven't made much progress this past couple of weeks.



- a. <u>Kingdom Financial Policy</u> has been updated to conform with a new template (that the SCA Corporate body has provided) and is currently with Their Majesties and Society Officers for perusal and approval. Kingdom Exchequer stated that this new template must be used and followed without modifications. I am currently reviewing the Barony's Financial Policies to see what changes must be made to conform with the new template. With that in mind, I foresee a full Financial Committee meeting in the near future and a Moot presentation and vote. We have until December 31st, 2020 to have our changes made, approved and submitted to the Kingdom Exchequer via our Regional Exchequer for inclusion to the Kingdom of Atlantia official website. - b. This is the <u>last call for volunteers</u> to be signatories for our Baronial Checking Account before the official submission. Need modern name, membership number and expiration date for the submission. All signatories must be 18 years of age or older, SCA Members in good standing for at least 90 days into the future, cannot share a domicile with another signatory, and cannot be our sitting Baron or Baroness. Our upcoming polling and Investiture may play havoc with this process and result in us repeating several steps but it must be done. We need to add:
 - Our current Seneschal (Greg Lemich)
 - 2. Our current Baronial Deputy (Cindy Madison)
 - 3. Our Kingdom Exchequer (Robin Leguillow) not local
 - 4. Our Regional VA Exchequer (Debbie de Treville) not local
- 5. And any other volunteers who wish to come forth and participate in an easily done baronial service.

- 4. It is also time for us to conduct an inventory of all Baronial Property. This means laying eyes and hands on every piece of property the Barony owns including contents of the Baronial Storage unit, gold key, cooking equipment, Pennsic encampment accessories (that are local), loaner armor (both armored and rapier), archery equipment, camping equipment, office machines, etc. I am open to suggestions as to how & when to schedule these activities but I would like to have the inventory complete before rainy & cold weather descends upon us.

Knight Marshal:

- 1. No official practices held during August 2020 to include Armored Combat, Rapier Combat, Youth Combat, Combat Archery, and Thrown Weapons. Virtual events as alternatives continue to be a viable option.
- 2. Official Target Archery practice held in accordance Kingdom of Atlantia established COVID-19 mitigation
 - measures. Developed training plan to get the Archery Company of Neptune ready for Royal Rounds.
- 3. Virtual armored fighting training. Baroness Catalina Riquel De Luna hosted Baron Mungoe virtual training via Zoom.
- 4. Armored Marshal 101. Sir Otto von Schwartzkatz has offered to virtually instruct an armored marshal 101. Coordinating with Baron Mungoe to identify heavy fighters to attend and have armored marshal MIT identified so when official events for armored fighting opens, we are ready. Johannes von Hammersbach will host via Zoom.



5. Target Archery Marshal 101. Johannes von Hammersbach will host Target Archery Marshal 101 with Lord Ivarr Thorgislsson to have Target Archery MITs to support official Target Archery practice and events, when allowed.
